MINI COURSES

What are Short Courses or Mini Courses?

In addition to the usual Semester One and Two courses there is the opportunity to participate in a short course in Italian. These courses are held during the winter and summer vacations and also on various occasions throughout the year.

Dante teachers provide different learning experiences. There are courses in conversation aimed at the beginner, the intermediate or the advanced level. Other courses present travel, cuisine or games integrated with study of the Italian language. And, of course, there are courses in various aspects of *Grammatica italiana*. Maybe you have missed a lesson or two and would like to catch up. Or you may need to revisit a particular topic to improve your knowledge and satisfaction. Here is the opportunity to accommodate your wishes.

Courses usually run in groups of two or three lessons. Each lesson is of two hours duration. Day and evening courses are available. You may attend all lessons of the course or whatever number suits you. Usually it is a better deal to attend the full course rather than attend an individual lesson.

STUDENTS' HINTS

When I was in Rome recently, there was a Hop on Hop Off bus ticket sales person nearby my hotel selling tickets. I showed him my Dante membership card & in my best Italian said I was a student all the way from Australia, so he instantly gave me 10% discount on my ticket. Therefore it is not necessary to book your ticket on line before leaving home. This has its disadvantages because there are several different companies operating, under the names of Red Bus, Blue Bus etc. They all just about offer the same tour & prices, but if you buy in advance you may find that the company that you booked with, their pick up spot may be far from your hotel on the other side of Rome. There are plenty of sales people dotted all over the place, & are very recognisable. It is important to make a note of the time your tour starts, that is when you board the bus, because they work on a 24 hr basis. So don't pay for your ticket at 9.00 am & not start the trip until 11.20am [I went & had a coffee] because your ticket will expire at 9.00am the following morning.

Try showing your Dante membership card at various venues e.g. museums art galleries, especially book shops when you are buying Italian grammar book, even some pharmacies are sympathetic when you try to speak to them in Italian. I must admit though it rather depends on a given person on a given day/ How Italian !

KNOW YOUR ITALIAN CHEESES (1)



PROVOLONE

No one knows exactly where this cheese originated but it was certainly among the earliest cheeses known by the Romans. The name can change in some areas due to shape – It can be spherical, pear-shaped, cylindrical, or plaited. The cheesemaker decides the shape and weight.

A Giganti (or monster) cheese is usually made for Trade Fairs displays and for special occasions, with some made to over 3 metres long. The most familiar sight is the sausage shape Provolone hanging by a cord in Delicatessens.

Dolce Provolone is aged for 2-3 months and is supple and smooth, with a thin waxed rind and is usually served as a table cheese.

Piccante Provolone is coagulated with rennet which gives it a strong bitey flavour. It is aged from 6 months to 2 years and is darker in colour with a hard rind and a strong spicy flavour. It is usually grated and used as a condiment.
