Facing Windows is a sensitive movie that covers many aspects of life. A married couple with two small children facing financial stress, resulting in unhappiness and bitter arguments. The wife watches a handsome single man across the way with envy. Inevitably they meet and there is a strong attraction.

The story covers an old man suffering amnesia, a holocaust survivor who is taken into care by the couple. This old gentleman, with a wonderful history, becomes a mentor to the young woman, who finally quits her mundane and exhausting job to follow her dreams. Homosexuality in the 1940's was not accepted, causing pain and heartache.
