## HAPPY ST. PATRICK'S DAY 17<sup>TH</sup> MARCH

Although many assume that St. Patrick is of Irish descent, he was actually not born in Ireland. No one knows for sure, but historians believe he was born in Kilpatrick, near Dumbarton in Scotland (technically a territory of Britain at the time) around 390. Patrick's parents were Calpurnius and Conchessa, Roman citizens living in Britain but most likely Scotland. Calpurnius, Patrick's father was a high ranking Roman diplomat living on a British estate.

Patrick was captured as part of a raid at age 14 and was brought to Ireland in slavery until he escaped at age 20 to France where he later became a priest, and on his return to Ireland, the second Bishop of Ireland. He spent the next 30 years establishing schools, churches, and monasteries across the country. He brought Christianity to widespread acceptance amongst the pagan indigenous peoples. Patrick succeeded in converting Chieftains and the entire Kingdoms, acquiring a large following of disciples. He built Ireland's first Church at Saul, where he later died around 461. (Historians cannot agree on dates of birth & death).

It is thought that St. Patrick used a shamrock as a metaphor for the Trinity (Father, Son, and Holy Spirit), showing how three individual units could be part of the same body. Soon his parishioners began wearing shamrocks to his church services. Today, "the wearing of the green" on St. Patrick's Day represents spring, shamrocks, and in Ireland a public holiday.

The St. Patrick's Day Parade in New York City, which dates back to 1762, is the largest in the U.S.A. and a major event for Irish Americans. More than 125,000 marchers participate, stopping at St. Patrick's Cathedral on Fifth Avenue for the blessing of the archbishop of New York. In Boston, the St. Patrick's Day Parade goes back even further, to 1737. In fact, during the siege of Boston which forced the British evacuation on March 17, 1776, General George Washington used "Boston" as the day's secret password and "St. Patrick" as the appropriate response.

So was St. Patrick Italian? Yes by heritage. And ... let's just say he had dual citizenship.
